Some Burn Cases:

1st Case:

Dua, a 6 year old girl was admitted in our Burns Centre on January, 28, 2017 with 39% fire burn. Dua had gone outside to play with her friends and they all started kindling fire in the woods so they could warm up their bodies. Unfortunately, fire caught on her clothes from which she got severely burned.

Initially her parents took her to a private clinic in Dadu, where she was treated by doctors but her condition got worse there. After 5 days her family decided to move her to Burns Centre-CHK. Our staff, with their dedicated work bought her back from the brink. Now she is stable and under treatment at our Burns Centre. She was operated upon multiple times and grafted to get the best result.



2nd Case:

Kausar Muhammad Sajjad, a 19 year's old female was admitted in our Burns Centre with 59% fire burn. She burnt herself with kerosene oil because she was having some conflicts with her husband. In burns centre our doctors not only treated her but also gave her guidance and counseling. After numerous sessions at the Burns Centre Kausar recovered and she is now doing amazingly well both mentally and physically.



Staff Focus:

I can confidently say that, Burns Centre gives me the reason to live and prosper in my life. I was admitted as the patient in the Burns Centre. It all started 8.5 years ago when my husband burnt me and I was taken to Burns Centre for treatment. I had 39% burns all over and my wounds were very deep. It took 5 months to recover and my husband left me in my hour of need the wonderful people of Burns Centre were there for me. They not only helped me recover but Friends of Burns Centre also provided me job here after my complete recovery. Now I am performing my duties at the Paediatric ward and I really cherish working here as every one at burns centre is just like family. Being a burn victim and working in Burns Centre and to everyone going through a terrible time I would say "never lose hope"

- Keep clothing from coming into contact with an open flame or heating equipment.
- Reaching over the stove cause garments to catch fire, especially the sleeves of a loose kameez, dupattas and saris.
- Avoid wearing flowing clothing while cooking and wear snug fitting or short-sleeved clothing.
- Use an elastic band to hold long or loose sleeves out of the way. Slide the sleeve cuff up to the elbow.
- Turn off the heat or gas before reaching over the stove.
- Keep children away from the stove, turn panhandles in, and cook on the rear burners when possible.
- If your sleeve should catch on fire, immediately cover the burning material with a potholder, mitt or towel, go to the sink and run cold water to put out the fire and cool the burn.
- Keep hot foods and drinks away from the edge of counters and tables. Don't set hot items on tablecloths because children can pull on the cloth and burn themselves.
- Don't hold a child and a hot object at the same time.
- Do not allow children to use the microwave without supervision. Children may not realize which dishes or containers are "microwave safe." Some plastics or paper can be overheated in a microwave and catch on fire.
- Steam burns to the face and hands are possible if the pressure cookers or dish is opened too early. After your dish is cooked, wait a short while for it to cool.
- Store all detergents, cleaning agents, bleach and other chemicals out of children's reach or in a locked cabinet.
- Before purchasing any household chemicals, read the contents label and the "caution" statement on the package.
