Mr. Ahmer Iqbal was a school teacher by profession in a private school.

The incident he suffered could not beat the braveness and morale of Ahmer. He regained his strength and faced the world again with all the handicaps he had due to this incident. Through his undaunted effort, he participated in the Master Chef competition in Pakistan and managed to get 3rd position. He also did online courses of customer service and retail sales. He is now easily using his smart phone, laptop and can even walk independently without any assistance. Ahmer also has a YouTube

Channel where he gives motivational lectures making people realize that nothing is impossible in this world. If you have a will to do something and be consistent, you can still do wonders. Against the agony he has been through, he has filed a petition in the Sindh High Court to Stop the Sale of Acid openly & easily.
