Mr. Sufiyan Khan – 18 year old Naat Khawa, who survived a gruesome homicidal acid attack by his competitor due to jealously as he got 2nd Position in Naat Competition while Sufiyan got 1st Position. He got affected on the forehead, both ears and whole trunk which were completely damaged. After this horrifying incident he was immediately shifted to the Burns Centre on 7th October, 2021, for treatment. The duration of the treatment and hospitalization at Burns Centre was 3 months in the Male Ward. After several procedures and debridement of skin he was discharged from the hospital on 29th December, 2021. Now he visits the Burns Centre fortnightly for regular check-up and physiotherapy

sessions.



The incident he suffered could not beat the braveness and morale of Sufiyan. He is now continuing with his job and also recites Naat with his heart touching voice. He also got the 1st Position in a "Naat Competition" which was held in the Government Boys Secondary School, North Karachi.
