TRIBUTE TO MR. S. M. MUNEER



"You have to go to the ends of the earth in order to leave the earth." Mr. S. M. Muneer most commonly known as "Bhai Jan" by those closest to him, 77, passed away on November 28, 2022. Mr. Muneer, a Pakistani businessman and industrialist served as patron-in-chief of KATI was born in 1945. Mr. S. M. Muneer was a well acknowledged person as he was a member of institutions like IoBM & Greenwich University, Karachi. In addition to also being a member of Board of Governors of several educational institutions. He remained as the leader of the business community with the Federation of Pakistan Chambers of Commerce & Industry (FPCCI). The work of Mr. S.M. Muneer was widespread; he was on the boards of Shaukat Khanum Cancer Hospital (Lahore) and The Kidney Centre Postgraduate Training Institute; his work further extended to managing several hospitals, maternity homes and schools in Karachi. Mr. S.M. Muneer was bestowed with multiple awards and honors in his lifetime, i.e. two LifeTime Achievement Awards in 2012 by the President of Pakistan and mayor of Markham Frank Scarpitti, to name a few.He was conferred the Ontario Canada Best Businessman of The Year Award by FPCCI and Sitara-i-Imtiaz in 2007 along with countless major awards and honors.

Mr. S. M. Muneer showed great generosity towards the Burns Centre. He was an illustrious philanthropist whose support helped the Centre to further our mission. Mr. Muneer played a vital role in the functioning of this organization as the a Patron-in-Chief, and we remain eternally grateful for his engagement with the Centre and the impact it has left behind.

CHILDREN'S POSTER CONTEST



A review of burn cases reveals that nearly all causes of burn injuries are due to the following three factors:

Lack of Awareness - Lack of Information Lack of Proper Education and Training

In line with its objective of creating awareness about burns and its safety practices among the masses, Friends of Burns Centre organizes Children's Poster Contest annually in collaboration with ZVMG Rangoonwala Community Trust.

This year, FOBC organized the Children's Poster Contest Awarding Ceremony at ZVMG Rangoonwala Community Centre on December 8, 2022. Mr. Islahuddin Siddigue -Former Field Hockey Player, Mr. Sadiq Mohammad -Former Pakistan Test Cricketer, Dr. Danish Faiz Khan -United Medical & Dental College graced the ceremony with their worthy presence as Guests of Honor. The Judges of the Contest were Mr. Jimmy Engineer - Artist, Mr. Munawar Ali Syed - Artist / Associate Professor, Foundation Programme, Indus Valley School of Art and Architecture & Ms. Mona Nagsh - Artist. Haseen Habib Trading demonstrated how to use a fire extinguisher and how to evacuate during fire. They emphasized the importance of awareness sessions for prevention from burn injuries. M. Art Gallery, ZVMG Rangoonwala Community Centre, Karachi.

SUCCESS STORY



M. Sufiyan an 11 year old primary school student was brought to Burns Centre from Baldia town on 19 January 2023. His two friends aged 14-15 worked at a mechanic shop after school to learn extra skills. On 19th January, Sufiyan and his friends got already lit coals in a box from a nearby eatery, assembled wood and took petrol out of a bike to add onto the wood to create fire in order to sit in a warmer atmosphere since it was cold. Since the coal had been already lit, adding petrol to it caused a huge fire which dispersed out and caught Sufiyan's clothes who happened to be sitting near the fire while his friends were standing some distance away. Luckily Sufiyan was wearing a helmet which prevented the fire from affecting his face.

Upon arriving at the Burns Centre Sufiyan was given emergency treatment which included IV line maintenance, (also referred to as ABC in medical terms). This was followed by a dressing procedure after which an assessment was done which revealed that Sufiyan had unfortunately suffered 37% fire burn. The very next day his left hand was seen swollen which led to a surgical intervention being performed immediately; this was to prevent pressure building up in his arteries and veins, and in this way his arm was saved.

After a week of admission in the Paediatric Ward, Sufiyan is expected to soon be discharged with great sign of improvement and recovery and with all the risks that he walked in with, eliminated.
