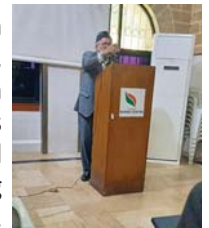

3) The taxpayer shall submit Performance Evaluation Report (PER) when received from the Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy or Chief Commissioner Inland Revenue.

This approval is valid upto 31-12-2023 unless cancelled or revoked earlier because of non-fulfillment of any of the prescribed conditions including the above.
